

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. While every care is taken in the maintenance of the facility, all persons swim their dogs and use our facility entirely at their own risk. Paws to Swim cannot be held responsible for any loss or injury to any person or animal while on premises.
2. We recommend all owners consult with their Veterinarian prior to letting their Dogs swim so that their Veterinarian can confirm that hydro-exercise (swimming) is an appropriate exercise for their pet.
3. Paws to Swim requires your dog to be up-to-date on their Rabies vaccination.
4. Owners are required to notify their Veterinarian if, during a course of swimming, the dog shows any unusual signs of physical problems or a current medical condition or injury worsens. They will also notify Paws to Swim if their Veterinarian advises swimming to be suspended.
5. Owners are requested not to feed their dog for at least 3 hours before attending an appointment, and to ensure that the dog has emptied its bowels before arriving. A surcharge of \$25.00 will be made for dogs that defecate in the pool (, as we may have to close the pool in order to remove it.) We also advise not to feed approximately one hour after swimming.
6. Female dogs in season will not be allowed to swim until over.
7. Dogs with infectious or contagious conditions, such as Ear, Eye or Skin infections, gastric upset, kennel cough and so on will not be allowed to use the facility until physical conditions have cleared.
8. Towels are NOT supplied. Please bring your own towel for your dog on each occasion. Towels are available to rent if needed.
9. Owners and their dogs must be out of the pool room immediately after their designated swimming pool session time has elapsed. Post swimming activities (showering, drying, etc.) must not interfere with other clients.
10. Chlorine is used to maintain pool chemistry.
11. We advise dogs to be showered off after their swim session.
12. All swimming sessions must be paid for on the day of the swimming session. Session fees will be charged in full if an appointment is broken or canceled without a 24-hour notice of the scheduled appointment.

13. No person(s) are allowed in the water without the authorization of the management of Paws to Swim.
14. Children under the age of 12 are not allowed in the pool area.
15. When visiting Paws to Swim you are advised to wear sensible shoes with non-slip soles if possible. The floor in the poolroom does become wet during your dogs swimming session and it may become slippery.
16. When not swimming, all dogs must be kept under control and must be on a lead at all times both in and out of the poolroom, and be leashed on the premises outside of the pool building. All dogs must be accompanied by their owner at all times and owners must be present with their dogs while in the exercise fenced-in fields. "One" client can only use the exercise field at a time unless the present occupant of that field gives permission.
17. It is the owner's responsibility to clean up after their dogs while on the premises and its surrounding environment. There is a scoop and bucket in various areas for your use. Under no circumstances are you to allow your dog to foul outside of the property.
18. Paws to Swim reserves the right to refuse swimming to any animal.
19. Paws to Swim cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to vehicles or personal property while on premises.
20. I understand that participating in a dog swim session is not without risk to myself, members of my family or guests who may attend or my dog. I hereby waive and release Paws to Swim, their employees, property owners, volunteers, owners, members, from any and all liability of any nature, for injury or damage which I or my dog, family or guests may incur, and I expressly assume the risk of such damage or injury while participating any swimming sessions or any function while on the grounds or the surrounding area or other location thereto.
